The **Delaware Valley Science Council regional science competition** for the 2011-2012 school year begins with examinations on the campus of Temple University on **Saturday, October 15, 2011**. A special testing session will be arranged only for students who cannot attend on Saturday due to religious reasons.

Each participating school may send up to **four senior students** who are graduating in 2012 and who have never participated in our competition. The students must complete **two examinations** selecting from mathematics, biology, chemistry or physics. Students should **arrive between 8:30 and 9:00 a.m.** for the exams. The exams are each one hour in length. Students will be dismissed at approximately 11:30 a.m.

PARTICIPANTS SELECTED FOR AN AWARD WILL NOT QUALIFY FOR THE AWARD UNLESS THEY ARE PRESENT AT THE AWARDS CEREMONY. EACH STUDENT MUST ALSO CONSENT TO THE USE OF HIS NAME, HOME TOWN, AND HIGH SCHOOL NAME IN PRESS INFORMATION RELEASED BY THE DELAWARE VALLEY SCIENCE COUNCIL.
